

## **Terms and conditions of application and participation for delegations**

By sending your application, you and every participant of your school's delegation accept and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of application and participation.

### **Privacy**

During the application procedure or on later occasions you will be required to provide personal information about all the participants (i.e. name, email address, phone number, etc.). This information is stored in the encrypted internal system of the organising team and only accessible by the members of this team.

Before and during the conference the name of your school and the country of origin will be published. The name, email address and phone number of delegates and chairs will be accessible by the chairs of the delegates' respective committees. The name, phone number and email address of every member of the delegation of your school, along with the arrival and departure dates of the delegation will be known by the supervisor students of your delegation and their host families.

The conference's media team will take photographs and video clips of all participants during the conference. These might be published on our website or social media channels.

### **Duties**

Please keep deadlines in mind prior to the conference and note that delegates are expected to:

Be familiar with the topic of their committee (including the Conference Guide and the respective Committee Guide);

Be familiar with the policies of their represented countries;

Cooperate with other delegates and committee chairs;

Come prepared to the conference (i.e. everyone has to write a Position Paper and Working Papers), be ready to deliver speeches and interact with fellow delegates.

All participants are to actively and constructively participate in all parts of the program specified in the official agenda.

### **Conduct**

MUN-Directors, delegates and chairs accept to maintain professional behavior before and during the conference week.

The consumption of drugs at school events is prohibited by German law. Please be familiar with the German Youth Protection Act, which you agree to adhere to at any time.

(children under 6 years of age only when accompanied by a person having parental authority. Presence will basically depend on the respective age rating! Exception: "Films for children of the age of 12 years and older": Presence of children of 6 years and older permitted when accompanied by a person having parental authority.)	until 8 p.m.	until 10 p.m.	until mid- night

### Public transportation

During the conference, all international delegates will receive passes to the public transport. If lost, a further conference ticket can be purchased for 20 €.

### Payment Policy

You will be required to pay the conference fee until the deadline, which is specified in the Secretary-General's official invitation.

With regard to extraordinary circumstances, parts of the fee can be refunded, if a delegation or a delegate is not able to attend the conference.

### Responsibility

The conference is not responsible for the safety and any of the actions of any participant before, during and after the conference. Therefore, the MUN-Director(s) of the delegation take(s) responsibility.
